3. In the story of Ling and the Emperor, Ling’s integrity is richly rewarded. The speaker warned, however, that integrity can sometimes cause people to miss out on opportunities. When has acting with integrity caused you to lose something? (For example, I once lost my job because I wouldn’t follow my boss’s [unethical] orders). If you could go back in time, would you still choose the same course of action? Why or why not?
