

Tentative Enrichment Schedule and Class Descriptions 2018-2019

Kindergarten Learning Block with Julie Glander, Grades TK-K

Students will explore, math, art and science through experiments, projects, reading circle, games and songs. Using fine and gross motor skills through projects, develop phonemic awareness through rhyming and word play, exploring the outdoors with their senses and more. "Hands on everything!"

Music with Brooke Chabot, Grades TK-K, 1

Students will learn to play ukulele and sing songs. They will explore music. Ms. Brooke is a local musician!

Home Economics/Healthy Living with Erica McDonnell, Grades 1-2, 3

Students will learn to bake and cook healthy treats and food. They will practice basic math skills in the kitchen. To balance out the baking and treats, students will learn about healthy eating and exercise.

Science with Lindsey Rodni, Grades 1-2, 3, 4-8

Grades 1-2- Students will learn about astronomy. With a focus on Greek and Roman myths about the planets. Each week will focus on a different planet, the sun and asteroid belt. Hands on experiments that cover the scientific process and lab reports.

Grades 3, 4-8- Biology spine with an aquatic or macro invertebrate focus. Hands on experiments that cover the scientific process and lab reports.

Ancient History with TBA, Grades 4-8

Students will explore the historical development of people, places and patterns of life from ancient times. This course offers balanced global coverage, with Africa, the Americas, Asia and Europe.

Cultural Geography with Julie Glander, Grade 3

Students will understand the relationship between where a person lives and how it affects their traditions and daily lives. This includes globalization, language, art, governments and economics. Students will explore different cultures through food, art, literature, dress, sports/recreation.

Art with Kindred Nicole Ashton Martin, Grades 1-2, 3, 4-8

Kindred Folk Art Institute will complete various arts and craft projects using found and repurposed materials.
