Dear Twin Ridges Parents and Families,

I am writing this letter to let you know that as of Monday March 23, 2020 the homeschooling portion of our program is open. The campus is closed to students until April 13, 2020 but our homeschooling program is occurring. For TRHS, this means that enrichment is still closed. In the meantime, enrichment teachers will be making enrichment lesson plans for students to do which will be emailed home.

Twin Ridges Home Study Charter will continue to run the home-schooling portion of the program. Please continue to instruct your students at home with guidance from your supervising teacher. Staff will still be working with the home-schooling portion of the program. This means that you are able to correspond with your supervising teachers but teachers and families are not to meet in person. This means all parent meetings will need to occur through technology. If you do not have reliable internet and/or computer, teacher meetings can be done over the phone.

Enrichment classes will be cancelled until after our Spring Break. Spring Break is April 6-10, 2020. We foresee classes being cancelled until the week of April 13<sup>th</sup> but given the nature of the situation we are facing, we will be sure to keep you informed regarding the reopening of enrichment classes.

Please keep in contact with your supervising teachers during this time and make sure to continue your instruction at home.
